3. The Travel Centre will do their best to include your journey, taking into account other bookings. They will agree a mutually convenient boarding and alighting point with you and the time the bus will pick you up.

4. If unable to book the journey you require, the Travel Centre will give details of other transport services in your area.

What is Tandridge Buses 4U Dial a Ride?

Tandridge Dial a Ride is a completely flexible, bookable transport service. The route and timings of the bus are determined by the requests made by would-be passengers.

Where do the buses operate?

The buses can be booked by anyone living in the Tandridge District Council area (please see the white area on the adjacent map). The bus will take you to anywhere within the area and home again.

The service will also go to: Redhill, Merstham, East Surrey Hospital, plus Horley and East Grinstead for medical reasons only.

The service is also suitable for people who cannot use conventional transport or who do not have access to their own transport. For those with mobility difficulties the buses are fully accessible by means of a passenger lift.

All our drivers have received specific training to assist passengers with limited mobility and are dementia trained. They hold an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service certificate through Surrey County Council.

Who can use the service?

The service may be used by any members who are Tandridge residents and have mobility difficulties or have no access to appropriate public transport or their own motorised transport.
